- Rahab teaches us it's not how you **start** that matters, but how you **finish**.

- Rahab had a **good heart**.
 - I Samuel 16:7 NLT
- A good heart is a heart that is **soft** and **pliable** to God and His ways.
 - Ezekiel 36:26 NLT
- **Check** your heart!
- Rahab had a **believing** heart.
 - Romans 10:10 NLT
 - John 3:16 NLT
 - Hebrews 3:12 NLT
- Have a **believing** heart.
 - Mark 12:30 NLT
 - Deuteronomy 6:5 NLT
- Rahab is in the "Faith Hall of Fame because she believed with her heart in **God** and **His power**.
 - Hebrews 11:6 NLT

- Rahab had a **loyal** heart.
 - Joshua 2:12-13 NLT
- Be **loyal** like Rahab.
