Miracle Defined:

- 1. a surprising and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws and is therefore considered to be the work of a divine agency.
- 2. a highly improbable or extraordinary event, development, or accomplishment that brings very welcome consequences.)

God is a **supernatural** being. Therefore whenever He is involved, there is **always the potential** for the miraculous.

With the LORD there is no such thing as **impossibilities**• Jeremiah 32:17 [NLT]

Examples of Miracles in Scripture:

- Abraham and Sarah having a son Isaac at 100 & 90 Genesis 21:1-3
- The parting of the Red Sea Exodus 14:21-30
- God causes the sun (earth) to stand still Joshua 10:12-13
- The multiplication of the Widow's meal I Kings 17:8-16
- The multiplication of a widows oil II Kings 4: 1-7
- Jesus turning water into wine John 2:1-11
- Jesus ealing the royal officials son John 4:46-54
- Jesus feeding the 5000 (men + women/children) John 6:5-14
- Jesus walking on water Matthew 14:23-25
- Jesus raises a boy from dead in funeral procession Luke 7:12-15
- Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead (after 4 days) John 11:1-44
- Jesus healing a man blind from birth (by spitting in his eye) John 9:1-7
- Jesus cleansing ten lepers Luke 17:11-14

A miracle is simply a sign that a reality that is **greater** than the **natural circumstances** has come onto the scene.

We need to raise our **expectations** to see the miraculous in our lives and the lives of others.
