

**THE WELLS OF SALVATION  
ISAIAH CHAPTER 12

Hebrews 2:1 KJVS [1] Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.

- **If we followers of Jesus are not intentional to listen to the things we have already been taught, we can end up living beneath our privileges and potential because we allowed the truth we once heard, to slip away from us.**

Isaiah 12:1 NKJV [1] And in that day you will say: "O LORD, I will praise You; Though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and You comfort me.

- **Your mouth will make you or break you!**

Isaiah 12:2 NKJV [2] Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For YAH, the LORD, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation."

- Revelation 19:11-13 NASB [11] And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. [12] His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems; and He has a name written on Him which no one knows except Himself. [13] He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.
- **As followers of Christ, we have to come to the place where we value the Word of God at the same level that we would value Jesus in person.**
- **Don't let anybody make you "feel some kind of way" for trusting the LORD to be your healer, and the one who enables you to prosper.**

Isaiah 12:3 NKJV [3] Therefore with joy you will draw water From the wells of salvation.

- John 4:13-14 NASB [13] Jesus answered and said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again; [14] but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life."
- John 7:37-39 NASB [37] Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. [38] He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'" [39] But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

• **The wells of salvation are on the inside of your spirit-man.**

Isaiah 12:4 NKJV [4] And in that day you will say: "Praise the LORD, call upon His name; Declare His deeds among the peoples, Make mention that His name is exalted.

• **When your faith is under trial, you're either going to talk about how "bad it is..." or how good God is.**

Isaiah 12:5 NKJV [5] Sing to the LORD, For He has done excellent things; This is known in all the earth.

• **Singing to the LORD is a spiritual technology of the Kingdom that triggers our deliverance in the times of trouble.**

- Psalm 32:7 NASB [7] You are my hiding place; You preserve me from trouble; You surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah.
- Acts 16:25-26 NKJV [25] But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. [26] Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed.

- 2 Chronicles 20:21-23 NASB [21] When he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who sang to the LORD and those who praised Him in holy attire, as they went out before the army and said, "Give thanks to the LORD, for His lovingkindness is everlasting." [22] When they began singing and praising, the LORD set ambushes against the sons of Ammon, Moab and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; so they were routed. [23] For the sons of Ammon and Moab rose up against the inhabitants of Mount Seir destroying them completely; and when they had finished with the inhabitants of Seir, they helped to destroy one another.

Isaiah 12:6 NKJV [6] Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, For great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

- **Your shout is your battle cry!**

- Joshua 6:20 NKJV [20] So the people shouted when the priests blew the trumpets. And it happened when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat. Then the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.
- Judges 7:17-18,20-21 NLT [17] Then he said to them, "Keep your eyes on me. When I come to the edge of the camp, do just as I do. [18] As soon as I and those with me blow the rams' horns, blow your horns, too, all around the entire camp, and shout, 'For the LORD and for Gideon!'" [20] Then all three groups blew their horns and broke their jars. They held the blazing torches in their left hands and the horns in their right hands, and they all shouted, "A sword for the LORD and for Gideon!" [21] Each man stood at his position around the camp and watched as all the Midianites rushed around in a panic, shouting as they ran to escape.
